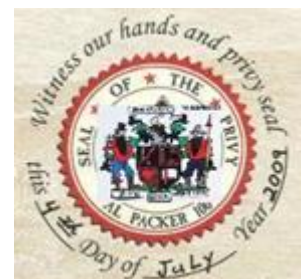

Howdy Dawg,

Concerning the Liberty Cemetery Flag Pole Project, it was indicated that members of 69 wanted to meet with members of 1841 Saturday night at Grand Council, and, we were available for that evening, however, the circumstances were the circumstances and the meeting dint occur.

What is the Liberty Cemetery Flag Pole Project you ask? Some members of 1841 met with the caretaker of the Liberty Cemetery in August of 2012 and were moved by the concerns expressed by the caretaker regarding the vandalism that occurs by bay area raiders on Halloween night which includes the defacing of monuments and the digging up of those entered for the purpose of harvesting skulls, and, about the flag pole which is not substantial and needs to be relocated. The caretaker was promised a Halloween night watch and a new flagpole.

Time slipped away and the flag pole was not relocated by Halloween night, however, there was a contingency of concerned citizens who camped out at the cemetery on Halloween night, and, although most of those citizens are in fact red shirts, this was not a "red shirt event" and so there was no ECV attire or other ECV signage. This contingency was visited by the sheriff, who had been advised by the caretaker of the night watch contingency, and by four unknown citizens who claimed to be local folks who just like to walk around in a cemetery on Halloween night and read the writing on the monuments, and, whether the Liberty Cemetery was on the bay area raiders' agenda for that Halloween night or not, the cemetery remained undisturbed that Halloween. More time slipped away, and, although Dave Hamilton requested we delay the project until after he became Noble Grand Humbug in October 2013, we still felt that this easy flag pole relocation project should have been completed already and planned to have it completed by the 12th of July 2014 - it would have been in the location specified by the caretaker, at an engineered depth demanded by the height, with a plaqueless concrete base (which may have had "ECV" embedded in the concrete) anchored sufficiently to withstand the forces of nature and discourage vandalism, with a "summer" flag and a "winter" flag which would be changed seasonally, and, with a solar powered light to illuminate the flag at night, and now, the flagpole has still not yet been relocated and I am sad to report... well... read on...

Those of us Clampers who gave the caretaker our word to provide a flagpole according to the caretaker's description/requirements are men of honor and our word is our bond, and, we believe that you and the 69 Brothers are men of honor and likewise your word is your bond, and, furthermore, we believe that because the 1841 Brothers and the 69 Brothers are all brothers and men of honor and likewise our word is our bond, therefore, upon further consternation, consideration and discussion, which included recalling that the \$2 soft boundary trespass agreement has been resended, we do therefore pass to you honorable 69 Brothers the task promised to the caretaker by the 1841 Brothers because the 69 Brothers are honorable men of their word and on the grand scheme of things are therefore bound by the word given by their Brothers who are men of their word.

We do, at this time, want to take this opportunity to ask for your pardon for passing to the 69 Brothers the task promised to the caretaker, whose contact information is available if you need it, and, ask that you and your fellow 69 Brothers bear no hard feelings because the caretaker expected a flagpole *LAST SUMMER* and now you will be bearing the responsibility of keeping our word and hopefully you will complete this project in a more timely manner than we did not.

Likewise we pass the Halloween night watch to you for the same reasons as stated above with our sincere apology for obligating you for a task you may not have been of a mind to take on, but, it is a worthy effort, so hopefully there will be no hard feelings on this matter either.

So let it be written, so let it be done.

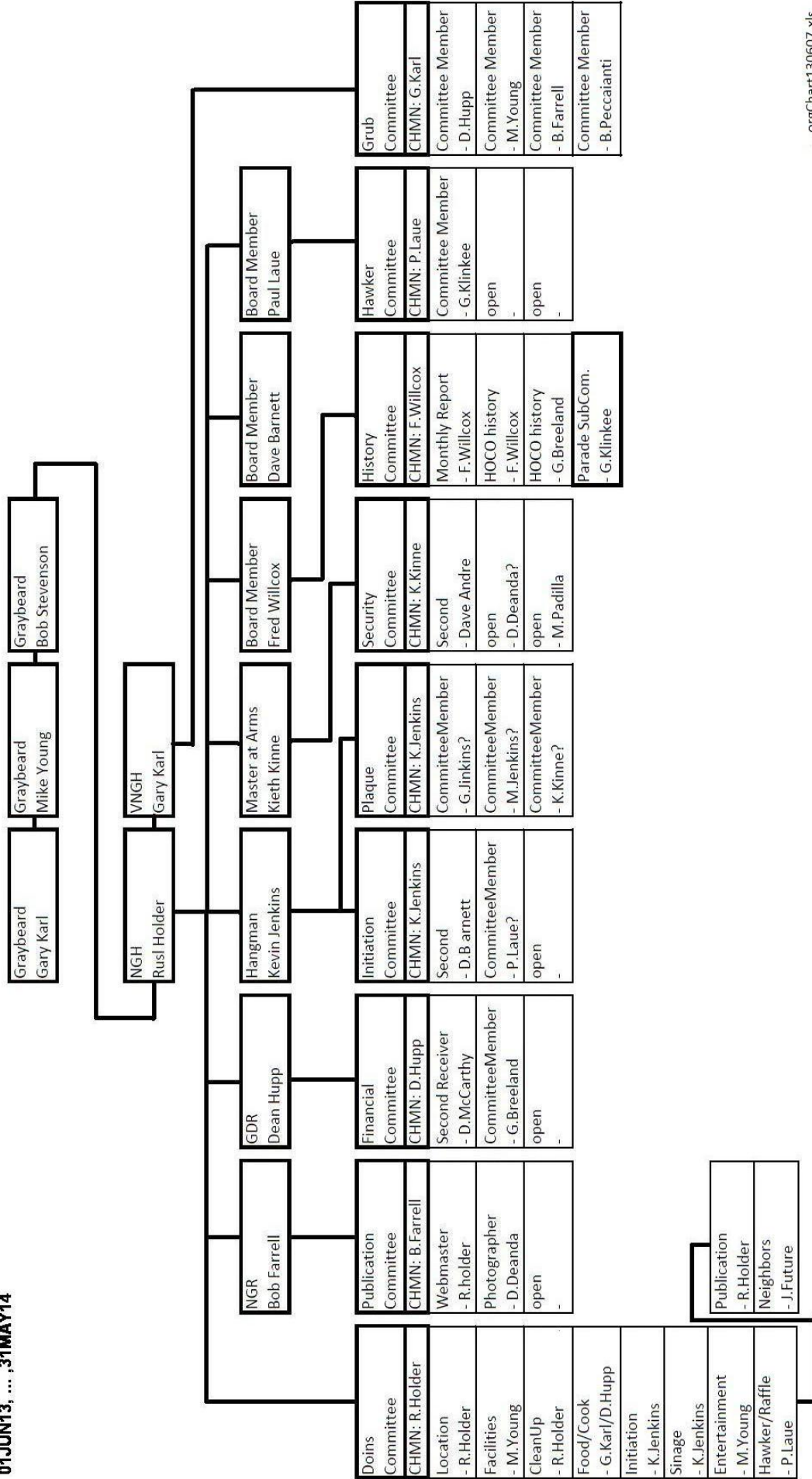
